2022 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Provided \$150K in scholarships to help pay tuition for our customers, allowing them to earn in-demand certifications, diplomas, and degrees.
- Provided \$17K in child care expenses, allowing our customers to go to school and training.
- Provided \$45K in transportation assistance allowing our customers to go to school and training.
- Provided \$28K for supplies, tools, books, and other items allowing our customers to go to school, training, and work.
- Provided \$40K of grant funding to local businesses to help them upskill their current employees, resulting in increasing the competitiveness of their business, helping them retain staff, and offsetting the costs of training new employees.
- Provided \$44K in wages to youth while they worked with local employers to help them develop soft and hard skills and explore potential career choices.
- Provided 41,377 employment services including resume assistance, interview preparation, skills assessments, and job search assistance to 4,516 job seekers in our region.
- Provided 6,224 services to 380 employers to help them recruit, retain, and train staff.
 - Assisted 44 businesses with new NCWorks Online registrations
- Conducted 43 employability workshops (in-person and virtually), allowing our customers to participate from anywhere throughout our 10-County region.
- Conducted 19 hiring events for local employers including one veterans' resource and job fair.
- Provided 808 career interest assessments to assist job seekers with identifying suitable careers.
- Served as a partner in Empower NENC: An Educational Collaborative, led by ECSU and intended to increase educational attainment in Pasquotank, Washington, and Tyrrell Counties.
- Increased virtual employability assessments, workshops, and outreach strategies
 - Launched an NWDB app where users can have the latest information right at their fingertips and pushed to them through notifications
 - Obtained virtual reality career exploration software for individuals to virtually try out careers
 - Provided 323 VR simulations
- Continued working on our Youth Initiative Grant to help expose youth to local careers and assist them with identifying and accomplishing their career goals.
- Increased Facebook reach to 16,587 and page visits by 2,209. Added 81 new followers.
