# Waves of Opportunity North Carolina Kickoff

HERTFORD – Funded by an \$11 million grant through the U.S. Economic Development Administration's American Rescue Plan Good Jobs Challenge, this groundbreaking training system will launch as a gateway for jobs in the maritime industry — maritime welder, electrical technician, wind turbine technician, sheet metal fabricator, structural fitter, commercial driver, and more.

Led by <u>the Hampton Roads Workforce Council</u>, the Regional Workforce Training System includes local partners, <u>Northeastern Workforce Development Board</u> (NWDB) and <u>College of the Albemarle</u>, as subawardees. Other local partners include a variety of employers who are connected to the maritime industry through production of goods and services or through connections with the defense industry.
